Day 1

Afterwards you'll have a Gata-making workshop and a delicious lunch!

Our next stop will be at the amazing Noravank Monastery. But wait, our adventure doesn't end here! We simply can't let you leave this canyon without experiencing something extraordinary. Get ready to explore "the oldest winery" in the world called Areni 1 by the archeologists!

Now the most exciting part of the tour! We are going to participate in the grape collecting process in vineyards and take beautiful photos!

Finally it's time for wine tasting and lunch! With every sip of wine, you'll savor a symphony of unique tastes, paired with locally sourced eco-products, creating an unforgettable culinary experience during lunch.
